Complaint: Yard has six vehicles without motors, 2 large truck bodies and a large lot filled with piles of junk.
Deadline: 30 days or January 10, 2005. 2nd follow up letter is to be sent.
January 6, 2005, Mr. Leinonen telephoned that he is in process of clearing the area. Four vehicles have been moved. He has been cleaning up behind the building. He takes the metal from the junk piles into his building workshop for cutting up. One truck body is being sold and the other is an unlicensed trailer.
